# Extremism

Beliefs that are very different from ordinary beliefs

Exclusivist, meaning it is only for a certain group or people who share those precise beliefs

A deep sense of belonging to a group that shares the same extremist beliefs

Can lead to violence or aggression

Can believe that there is someone or something to blame for their misfortune

Might involve a sense of being let down by society
