<b>British Values</b>	<b>Some examples at Liskeard School... Can you think of any more?</b>
Individual liberty	<p>You get to choose your GCSE and A Level options.</p> <p>Student council and student surveys give you your say.</p> <p>You have the freedom to attend a wide range of extra-curricular activities &amp; trips</p>
Democracy	<p>You are taught about politics in PHSE and how a democratic political system works.</p> <p>You vote for your Student Council reps.</p> <p>You are given opportunities to vote at mock general elections and the EU referendum</p> <p>Some of you have been part of hustings with local MPS and councillors</p> <p>You have the opportunity to take part in debating and public speaking competitions.</p>
The Rule of Law	<p>You follow rules on a day to day basis within school &amp; understand the consequences of breaking them.</p> <p>You are taught about the law within society in PHSE, e.g. Human Rights.</p> <p>Some of you have taken part in the Mock Magistrates competitions.</p>
Mutual Respect	<p>As part of PHSE you are taught about 'healthy relationships', anti-bullying, sexuality, identity and the importance of respecting individuality. You may have had sessions from Barnardo's, CLEAR and Brook.</p>
Tolerance of those with different faiths and/or beliefs	<p>You all attend Religious Education lessons in which topics covering Christianity, Islam, anti-racism and prevention of extremism are taught. These topics allow you the opportunity to discuss ideas and viewpoints that you may agree or disagree with, but ultimately help you reflect on your own views and appreciate that others may think or feel differently.</p>
