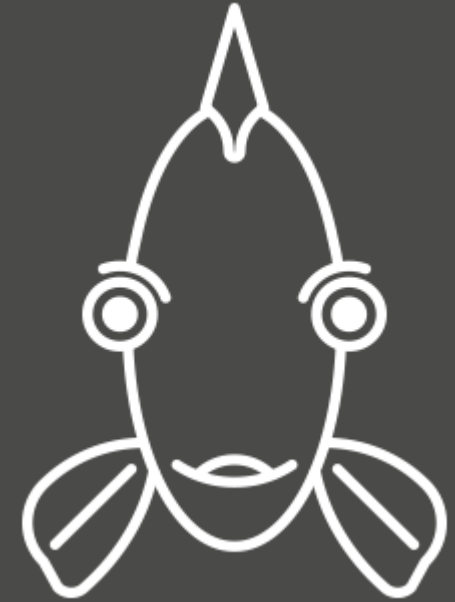

Task 2

- Research **TRANSFERABLE SKILLS** (look at least three different websites) and produce a **PowerPoint presentation** or a series of **posters** to cover the following:
 - ❑ What are 'Transferable Skills'?
 - ❑ **Eight examples** of Transferable Skills that you think are the most important.
 - ❑ Explain why each one is important for people in jobs regardless of what that job is.

Task 3

- Identify the Transferable Skills that you think are **strengths** of yours and give examples of how you have developed those skills. For example, you may believe you have developed your 'Ability to Work in a Team' when playing for a sports team.
- Identify the Transferable Skills that you think you need to **focus on developing** and explain how you are going to do this for each one.

Extension Task(s) – choose one or both

- Write a short report (2 or 3 paragraphs) explaining how Transferable Skills are important to you now and how they will be important to you in the future
- Write a short report explaining why Transferable Skills are more important to young people in 2020 than they would have been to young people twenty years ago.
